- 6:00 PM Dinner for judges and judges' secretaries
- 6:30 PM Novice & CP briefing for riders and volunteers – don't miss this!
- First Time Riders (or any riders with questions) Meeting immediately after briefing with TBD
- After Briefing Get tracks loaded onto your GPS (at registration office or download online)
