

GREENLAND OPEN SPACE COMPETITIVE TRAIL RIDE -Leisure Division  
May 30 & 31, 2026.

LOCATION: 1532 E. Noe Rd, Larkspur, CO 80118 (between Castle Rock and Colorado Springs)

Come ride the open, rolling grasslands and oak dotted hills of the historic Greenland Ranch, with unending sky and miles of views of Pikes Peak, the front range, interesting rocky outcroppings, mesas and scattered groves of oaks, pines and willows. This ranch sits on the north slope of the Palmer Divide and is home to many species of wild life as well as friendly, grazing cattle. This is a very easy early season ride with excellent footing and easy elevation changes on both single and double track trails. You will ride about nine miles at an average speed of 3.7 mph. Time will be between 2.5 to 3 hours, with 4 to 5 judged challenges en route and a 15 minute P&R break..

CAMPING: plenty of space available -Friday and Saturday nights only, in a fairly level field.

DIRECTIONS TO CAMP: From I-25, take Greenland, EXIT 167. Turn west for ¼ mile, then south ½ mile into the park. Camp will be in the open field east of the normal parking lot /picnic shelter and north of the dog park parking lot.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Horse water “may” be available in limited quantity, by the parking lot but If not, management will do their best to provide horse water in the area. If you can bring your own that would be helpful. Do bring your own people water and food. Dogs must always be on leash, though there is the adjacent leash-free dog park. No dogs at ride briefing or awards, please. There is cell phone reception in camp and on trail. Limit of 25 entries each day.

SCHEDULE: both days, Riders check in (receive rider packet) between 8:30 until 9:30 a.m. with ride briefing at 9:45 a.m. and untacked horses checked in with the judge starting about 10:15 a.m. Competitors will time out around 11:30. Awards ceremony asap after check out. Turn in vests!

RULES: Ride will be conducted under current NATRC rules. Out-of-state horses are required to have a current Coggins and Health Certificate. Be prepared to show the ride secretary. (rule book and lots of information can be viewed on the website- [natrc.org](http://natrc.org))

AWARDS: Awards and prizes will be 1st thru 6th for Adult, Experienced (250+ hours of NATRC competition), and Junior classes for horse/rider team.

MEALS: On your own. Saturday evening potluck -if enough interest-TBD. Volunteers get breakfast and lunch on day of volunteering.

JUDGE: Linda Johnson-Conne

FEES: \$85/members. Non members add \$25. Junior members, deduct \$30. Junior non-members are \$95.

Discount: deduct \$10 if sending FULL payment. BEFORE APRIL 15.

Late fee: \$10 will be added if registering OR sending deposit after May 15 .

DEPOSIT: \$35 is due immediately after registration on RMS-(<https://rms.natrc.net>) to hold your spot. Cancellation Refunds upon request (less \$20 admin fee) until May 29th.

Registration closes May 25, but late registrations will be accepted on day of competition, but cost an additional \$20.
